Psychology

Trying to Help

Like a hunter stalking their prey Emotions tend to sneak up on you Like being startled by a sudden noise Depression can come out of nowhere

It is hard to define how I feel
As emotions change like the direction of the wind
In a series of waves like the ocean tide
I am easily overcome with feelings

Depression is a feeling of hopelessness While paranoia is an instinctual terror Depression makes a person feel like not trying Paranoia often drives a person to try too much

When the hurting is not visible
Other people don't know how to understand
When the hurting is not something they have experienced
Other people do not know what to say

Even while hurting and alone It is important to remember Only so much can be expected of others People can only give of themselves so much

Our energy is not endless And all of us can be pushed over the edge Eventually professional help is what is needed One individual will burn out If they do the job of four people

Like trying to be politically neutral Or making a church multicultural There is little a church can do That will help all mental needs

It is endearing and extraordinary
To want to help everyone
But some things are just too complex
And require too much time and energy
To bring about a stable condition

Too often we expect religion
To solve all problems
Or think that just knowing God
Will resolve longstanding difficulties

Some pain and misunderstanding Will be there until Christ returns As the consequences of sin are grave

Spiritual death is no small thing Whether it is us or the world that has died

I can empathize with with those Trying to understand How to deal with issues They cannot relate with Either by experience or training But still wanting to help

Maybe we have to accept imperfection In the Church

Whether it is doctrinal or cultural issues Medical or financial

The Church has faced many crisis As do their members Sometimes daily As the song goes "I need thee every hour"

Today the American church faces an existential crisis What role does the church play in society? How are we to work in a world That has given up on God?

We cannot give up on them ever As God never gives up on us Maybe we just need to be silent And wait upon God to respond

We need to learn from our history
We need to sever political connections
We need to more gentle about evangelizing
We need to speak out on financial inequality

We need a parallel church That would be everything the American church is not

It would be mystical, personal, and small It would focus on the needs of a neighborhood And not identify with any political issues

It would make peace with unbelievers And it would accept

That not all things
Can be solved through doctrine

The Church does not need to give up on meetings But maybe the way we structure churches Could benefit from radical change

Maybe a house based Bible study church Would be a successful model For a society where the Church is being marginalized

Instead of us resisting cultural threats
To our race, class, and language
We need to celebrate these demographic revolutions

When there are so many problems And such limited time and resources We need to find a way to prioritize

If evangelism is our priority We need to let things go That sidetrack this objective

What does the Church want to be known for? Race, class, and language Or faith, patience, and self-control

Who do we want to be as Christians? We need to not just repeat What we have heard from others

We need to make a choice And we will have to live with the consequences

Now much of society sees Christians Like they see the mentally ill

It would be good if they keep from Seeing us as a serious threat We don't want to set up ourselves for persecution If we suffer it should be for God Not for cultural issues

Being Different

I have been told I am unique But I think it is more That I have an unusual combination of views

Other people thought of these ideas long before me And these ideas would not be considered to be so unusual At almost any other time in history

Many people today want to be different But being truly different does not make you famous And it is much harder to sell truly original things

Being unusual makes it harder to fit in This is not a good thing This makes you feel uncomfortable within every group

There are so many people in the world There must be many people in your same position No matter how original you think your ideas are

One of the ways to find joy in life Is not to be at the center of attention Living for something greater than yourself Brings joy and fulfillment

Not everyone can or should be a leader If there are no followers There is little point in creating a group

Some people do have their own culture

But you can get to be so different That other people cannot comprehend a word you say

Having a common purpose is important for national security Ideology is more important than the military for a nation

Every country has a slightly different social contract with the people

This is their justification as to why they should rule And their competitors shouldn't This is one of the major drivers of history

I do not comfortably fit in to any group I have to get good at explaining myself I have to quickly justify why I think the way I do

Unique or different may be cool
In some regions or cities in this country
But things are developing in the opposite direction
In other regions and cities in this country

There are certain specific behaviors
That are more accepted today
But none of these involve accepting different ideas

Creativity is a great strength That I hope everyone can master But it is most effective in solving problems

Being creative is not entertaining for the most part But it does help a person cope With problems they encounter in their lives With the common goal of living with less pain

Conforming to other people's ideas
Has gotten a bad reputation lately
But when you have any kind of movement or organization
You inherently already have mass conformity

Most successful attempts at free expression on a large scale Have been successfully sabotaged By corporations seeking to sell more things To make a mockery of independent thinking

No one wants you to have your own ideas And if you want to really change something That would affect many people You will inherently run into opposition

Our situation was designed the way it is This wild ride we are on through technological change And its various effects on our culture Is not accidental

People in power deliberately created the situation That we are in today Because they wanted the things to happen That most people see as negative

Whenever you try to make a meaningful change You are inherently challenging their power And they will effectively resist your efforts

If that is not effective at making your ideas Not work or not be adopted They will keep changing tactics

Eventually they will go after Your family or your reputation

But in cases that require this You may simply disappear And wake up at a dark site

Some hole somewhere with very good security Likely on some boat in the middle of the ocean The kind of place designed to hold agents And keep them from escaping

I learned as a kid to try to change the world Later I learned the world is a very cruel place And trying to change this at scale Will make your life miserable

But one thing you can change is yourself You can change your thinking And this will change your actions This will improve your life more Than any external factor

This is also the way to making lasting change In the world today It is hard to argue with someone Who wants to improve their own morality

And this will have ripple effects
This will produce changes too subtle to track
And no one will be willing to accept
That this was the cause

Remember evil does run this world But Christ has overcome death and hades/hell The devil can only do limited damage As he has to get permission from God To do anything of significance

Joy of Uselessness

All of us seem to encounter At least one life changing crisis Over the course of our lives Some we may not even want to survive

There are many things in life we cannot avoid Today everything of interest is public or will be soon

But today like throughout recorded history
We have been able to avoid being targets
Of powerful and violent people
The trick is to truly offer no value to such people

There really is no point in being famous in America today We have transformed our society Into one where you can technically express yourself But only in very specific ways

Today America's world empire
Is being backed by an ideology
With complete and blind acceptance and ownership
No matter what the personal cost
By at least millions of people in the homeland

The Church which constantly fears their ideas
Might shift a little in different cultures
To adapt to different needs and different expressions of faith

Have without any kind of reservation or reflection Decided that you must accept Evangelical culture

To go to Heaven and be right with God And similar ideas have been synchronized With the Christian faith in many cultures

The greatest ideological threat to the Church Outside America is its connection to America

If Americans get to claim
They are closer to God and more devout
Because they have more wealth and a more powerful military
Why can't Christians in other countries
Have an even better claim to be true believers
As they are more likely to suffer for their faith?

This arrangement only advantages a few rich people Who have no loyalty to anyone but themselves And are not in any way meaningfully affiliated with Christianity But have the Church's unwavering and unconditional support

Democracy never had a chance They don't want to leave The important issues up to a vote If they did that then The outcome might not be easy to control

America is hated throughout the world Because we want the world's resources cheaply But we don't want to bother To learn about any other culture Because we think people in other countries That reject our culture are evil for doing so

We think the solution to problems

The world has struggled with for millennia Can be solved in a few years If we send in our military

We think we can destroy their country But save their lives And get them to abandon their culture in appreciation

This is one of the reasons
Why I would never travel outside America
In my military service I very closely missed
Getting thrown into some very scary situations

This is why I now take as few risks as possible

I deliberately talk in generalities
When I criticize what I think is wrong in the world
And have no interest in connecting the dots
That would identify those who control such things
Or the means in which they control these things

I do not try even if I could To get in any position of power I try to treat others as gently as possible And interact as little as possible online

I learn enough about technology To stay a little ahead of the curve

There will likely be a time in the near future That I will not be able to speak as freely Because of the unintended consequences Of legislation targeting tech companies

Or evolution of technology That makes writing irrelevant

Everything has a cost You cannot make money off of free You may find someone to serve as your patron But they will want something valuable in return

I am in the unusual situation That I have never made any money Off of any of my creations

Throughout history most writers needed financial backing They could not speak as freely as I do Because they needed money to survive while creating And writing has always been a niche market

We see the academic world today as very biased But this has always been true

Most writing has had extremely political Motivations and meanings
This is why writers are often persecuted If they are viewed as relevant
To established powers

The biggest protection of a country is its ideology And the best protection of an individual Is to not stand out

So you may question why I do not promote my ideas better I see little advantage in doing so for anyone

Some ideas are only relevant To a very small group of people

Americans have the freedom of expression they do Because a few companies control all the means of publication Individual voices are lost in the static of millions of others

This is a good thing and makes me happy It only sounds negative To those who would not be interested In what I am trying to communicate

It is almost completely nonsensical For society to adopt individuality On a massive scale

This has been a strategy of the powerful To destroy the message of those Who want to live differently

I am not afraid of that outcome As there is no easy money to be made With my ideas As too few people Would care about my ideas

Mature Faith

I have often thought that I should Do everything I can To prepare for any scenario

But I have recently realized That just like Christ told us To prepare for His second coming By being kind

So the best method of protection Is to pray to God

We cannot expect God to prevent Anything bad from happening to us But He does love us unconditionally

If we want God to forgive us No matter what we have done We should accept whatever God sends our way

Just like if we want God's mercy We must forgive our enemies A relationship has to work both ways

We live in God's world And we have to accept Him Despite not knowing our future

Like joining the military You make a commitment

Before you have any idea Of what you have committed to

God truly controls everything So it make sense to go to the top position If He is willing to listen

I cannot reject God Even if I disagree with Him on some things Because He accepts me And I know I have done things He disagrees with

The best antidote to fear is thankfulness
If we are going to fear trials
And question why God allows them
It is only fair to feel gratitude
When something good happens

If we want a mature relationship with God We have to put in some work as well

God does not need to be forgiven Because He cannot do evil

Maybe we need to accept That it is acceptable to disagree with Him But we still need to obey Him

Is is true that God gives us rules That we need to follow To have a happier life But it is enough that He commands us

We need to follow Him Even when we don't understand Or the answers are not always given

There are many things beyond our understanding Suffering might just be one of those things

It is good to be responsible Treating others kindly and avoided accidents Wisdom can help us escape Some of the worst fates many times

But we need to accept that this is not our home And we are not the ones in charge here

God is good and wants the best for us Suffering does not negate this I just means that we do not have a simple answer

The Bible is not always comforting Especially for non-believers Or believers shortly after sinning But it is always true

I have trouble getting myself to read the Bible But afterwards I am always glad I did

Unfortunately we live in a dangerous world And we still have a very limited understanding Of even just the physical world There are factors we cannot comprehend

Furthermore we have very little wisdom

As reflected in the problems That we get ourselves into

The only sure thing is that Christ Has made a way To be reconciled with our Creator

It cost Him everything
But it is available to all people
This should give us hope

We should be gracious about it Because He was willing to suffer for us He will never leave us alone Or force us to do Anything we don't want to do

Maybe the best way to deal with suffering Is to do everything we can do To stop the suffering of others

The only thing we can really change Are our own actions and beliefs Maybe even simple kindness Is more powerful than we think

Drowning in a sea of voices All angry and all loud Surrounded by crowds Of various sizes

I choose to speak so softly
That only a few can hear
Deliberately limiting my message
To only be relevant
To other minds like mine

A place of quiet The voice of just one person With no followers

How do we prove We are not the same As the rich and powerful Feeding off the poor and marginalized?

Think small in all ways Be inefficient and subtle

Do not fight your enemy Simply go around him

Struggle against the noise By being even more subtle and gentle

Do not go for numbers

Refuse to engage people who disagree Keep your group from organizing Strive to stand as individuals

Never agree on doctrine Be nowhere and therefore everywhere Be so soft and warm That your ideas dissolve in the culture

Form a different culture For every single person Be the anti-movement

Seek to do small things For only a few people

Put great time and effort Building one person's character Rather than trying to change a nation

Stop trying to compete with opinion leaders Be peaceful and unconcerned With message or followers

Deliberately refuse to be an institution Of any kind or form Be only known by your first names

Treat others as they are more important Than an entire country or culture Stand alongside those who do not fit in But not in any visible or quantifiable way

Try to be so unsuccessful by today's standards So that you do not attract businesses Be so unorganized that you keep no list of people

Do not accept any request for media coverage Never set up any infrastructure So that corruption is inconceivable Do not make a logo or use a name

Believe that the only way for salvation Is to seek God with all your heart

Do not be all things to all people Only be one thing to one person

The way to spread the Gospel Is to hide it in your heart

The great battles of today are not physical Do not concern yourself With things outside your immediate sphere of influence

Spend all of your time Outwitting the evil in your own heart

Forget what you have learned in school And give up on having any influence In material or social spheres

Be not who you are Rather be who God says you are

Do not concern yourself with

The heresies of other people Worry more about The corruption of your own mind

Do not try to save the world Try to save yourself

Do not try to solve the Bible Accept that most things in life Especially concerning God Will forever be a mystery

This is the faith as I see it

Freedom Equals Wealth

Many Christians today Believe everyone should be a theologian There is even a book by that name By a famous theologian

Protestantism did so well in America Because we express our devotion Through materialism

A million variations of very similar beliefs Is not useful to spread the Gospel But it is useful for capitalism

The best way to limit the power of the Church Is to marginalize the spiritual

The Church in America has always had a fear Of both the supernatural and traditional ethics In any Church contexts

When you ally yourselves with the rich and powerful Like with major political parties
You take on their negative associations as well

If the American Church wants to associate itself With the poor and marginalized It must make some major political, financial, and theological changes

For a while it was sustainable

For the ultra wealthy to get richer And for regular Americans to not get poorer

But now that the Middle East, China, and India Have a little of our wealth We now have to share the wealth

Regular Americans can no longer afford high margin items That only Americans can produce So there are no more opportunities to grow The American share of the world's wealth

Americans now are faced with a situation Where they have to make choices Outside what luxuries to buy

Do we want freedom or security?
Do we want independence or unity?
Do we want wealth or to be compassionate?

Every American thinks they are poor But 75% of the world's population Would be considered below the poverty line in America

If everyone in the world received the same wage Most Americans would be much poorer

The same groups that want to bring the Gospel to the Muslim world

Are creating an Apocalypse in the same areas of the world In some ways, they are preaching a self-fulfilling prophecy

The inconvenient truth is that

Many ideas of America's wealthiest Do not align with the values Of a literal interpretation of the Bible

The same people that denounce southern Californian culture Have the culture and freedoms they do Because it is being exported to Asia

Ideology protects America more than the military This is the international equivalent of the saying "You cannot lock up everyone" That is used in reference to domestic policing

God and Uncertainty

People fight over theology Because the Bible is often unclear And appears different To different people

The purpose of this has eluded many I now think the purpose Is to build our faith

When Jesus came to earth
He could have revealed He was God
In a way that would be obvious
He could have proved Himself to everyone
So everyone would believe Him

Jesus also could have given an account for Himself Or why we have to suffer But He did neither He remained silent on these issues literally He did address these issues by His actions

The consequences of sin are greater Than we can imagine This is why God hates sin This is what really angers God Because it really hurts us literally

Maybe Heaven will require faith too In the famous passage about love In 1 Corinthians 13

Three things are important in Heaven Faith, hope, and love

Faith to understand God Love to get along with others Hope for something I don't know

I think today especially
We want to and expect to
Know everything and see everything
We all want complete transparency
We have to as we no longer have any trust

Many people are very interested in prophecy Because they do not apply their faith And trust God has good reasons Why He doesn't reveal this

Certainly the first time He came Turned out really good for us So why would His second coming Be any less positive?

To understand the future
We need to understand the past
To understand the Gospel
We need to understand the Old Testament
This is a good reason to read the Bible

God came through before So we know He will in the future

The great Christian mystics of the Middle Ages

Did not want to have any supernatural experiences Even positive ones from God Because they were concerned about becoming proud

Some of the reasons why we don't see spiritual things It would be detrimental to our faith Another reason is that it would be too intense And finally it would likely develop into an addiction Even in Heaven we will have physical bodies The physical world was created by God so it is good

Science and religion are often antagonistic to each other Science doesn't like faith
Because they only think in terms of what is rational So they feel this undermines their ability
To influence others through their discoveries
Most of their political objectives are very noble though

Religion should not like Science
Because people begin to think
That they do not need God
As the spiritual seems irrelevant
If you only concern yourself with can be measured

Religion never changes Science changes very fast Religion requires people to slow down Science makes it hard to do this

Many people think we can have our cake and eat it too They think we can embrace both science and religion Because they think rejecting science Makes them seem less educated

This is very much not true

We want to have faith
But we never want any struggles
We say we will stay with God
No matter what
But give up or run
At the slightest obstacle

The disciples of Jesus did the same thing But they did overcome this later And grew spiritually beyond this

The Apostle Paul wrote about this
As we are as Christians very immature spiritually
We think some sins are insignificant
We focus on the very first part of salvation
But we do not commit ourselves to developing spiritually

We want God in our lives
When we need Him
But do not stay in contact
In both the exciting and mundane times
Maybe that is why
Christians have the same divorce rates
As unbelievers do

I think of uncertainty as something to dread But this is not emotionally healthy I know something about fear As I have Schizophrenia As a result of my military service

We have to believe God will never give us More than we can take

Religion is very difficult Because it requires sacrifice We keep asking and trying to get more But we might be happier with less

When we read the Bible
We often think it is boring
And that is part of the point in reading it
As this helps develop discipline

But the bigger issue is The Bible requires us to make decisions God doesn't want people not fully committed Many people think this is unfair

But why would you want to go to Heaven If you do not like God?
Ultimately God makes the rules
As it is His Heaven and His earth

Even the devil has to follow them And is often forced to If someone is in power in the underworld It will likely be one of God's angels Not the devil

Positive Developments

One of the biggest traits
That I see exemplified by God
Both in the life of Jesus Christ
And in the interaction with The Lord
Over the millennia of history covered in the Old Testament
Is the value called kindness

I have seen a tendency
For some in the Church to reject this
Much as their is widespread rejection
Of animal rights and the possibility of racial issues

I see the idea of random acts of kindness
And some of the proposed expansions of civil rights
And constitutional protections
From excessive force by the justice system
As an aspect of society that could be driven
By the moving of the Holy Spirit

I have realized from talking to my sister That there are positive developments in society now This is one of the biggest issues I am aware of

Even technology that scares me
For how easily it can be abused
Could be used responsibly and be genuinely useful
If it is used to empower those with limitations
Due to various disabilities

Some Christians now believe that there needs to be

A line drawn in the sand And that we have to choose one end Of the political and social spectrum

If the choice is between fascism and communism I choose to drop out or only vote for 3rd parties

I do not know where this places me ideologically But I believe the biggest problems today Arise from a lack of kindness across the board

Our first inclination seems to be switching over time To acting fast and choosing not to think We should all be able to agree being gentle and slow acting Should be a sign of maturity And not merely a sign of weakness

For those who reject violence Under any foreseeable circumstance It is hard to understand this drive to win Any kind of debate just makes me want To avoid interacting in those situations

Obviously I too struggle with All of my ethical deficiencies as well Some are just harder for me to understand

I see many problems with the modern world Living at the expense of our descendants And the majority of the world population Plus the pollution of the planet And the elimination of entire species

For even useful things like medicines This seems very short sighted

There are some great medicines today
Especially for pain management
But we cannot use them for uses they were designed for
Because so many have used them improperly

This shows that the problems we have Are not solvable by science for the most part

Our biggest problems are not that we lack Understanding or intelligence But rather that our lack of empathy Is a more primary limitation and source of conflict

Science answers most questions that revolve around The answer to how should we do something But fails badly when we try to use it solely To determine what we should do

The problem we cannot resolve is Why should we do these things

To do this we might need to value the arts and humanities In order that we might address these deeper sources of division

Another related area of interest for me Is the growing awareness of the emotional aspects Of being human or animal

That has great potential value for improving who we are This is a relatively recent realization

But we have only scratched the surface of possibilities

We are not just body and spirit
But emotions matter too
And complex problems need to be dealt with
By realizing that there are interactions
Between all these elements

It is truly encouraging that a few people see no conflict Between physical, emotional, and spiritual approaches To problem solving Some are even devout believers within Christianity

If earlier civilizations had a very basic level of understanding In the fields of modern psychology and the social science of economics

This would be like having a superpower level ability
To avoid war and debt and adapt to social changes
This might have preserved the Roman Empire to this day

Certainly we would be better off trading A better understanding of technology For insights into people

Technology cannot solve problems If people are unwilling to change How they live and learn new habits

Many modern sources of death Could be resolved better by discipline than technology

It is great to know about new medicines But it is usually better to prevent the disease

From happening at all

We are getting much better at surgery Largely because of cutting as little as possible But you cannot just take something out And put something else in And expect everything to work as before

Even the military and veterans are now embracing Traditional Chinese Medicine And pushing education to prevent disease

Again the big obstacles often lie Within our minds and in our choices We need to discipline our thinking and actions In place of merely adding more procedures

Religion

Jesus Revolution

Jesus was so revolutionary conceptually That we still poorly understood Him

Jesus most challenging topics Are the ones concerning His teachings If we listen to His silence and actions Maybe we can understand His words

God wants us to seek Him He wants us to choose Him

We see struggles in life As something to solve and move past He wants to be with us And guide us through the fear

We often have a hard time Making a place for God in our lives Maybe we should just try to be more like Jesus Rather than just following what He said

It is true that Jesus did not change the rules In a way He simplified them

We are to prioritize God over everything else If we follow our conscience The rest will follow naturally

What God asks us to do and not do Are not hard to understand

They are actually very similar To other world religions and governments

One way to look at the Bible Is we are gradually being revealed More and more about God

Job knew much less about God But surprisingly He did better Dealing with a very traumatic situation

He realized much about God Although he was taught very little In terms of theology and doctrine

Today we are overloaded with information This distracts us from God

This makes it much harder To seek God And let Him transform our minds This is no small thing

One of the things Jesus kept doing When He encountered more and more stress Was He prayed in solitude

It is interesting that when we think of bad habits We think of addictions Maybe good habits can be a counter addiction

Maybe those with a predisposition to addiction Should not try to overcome their personality

But rather change the focus and what they pursue

Part of Christianity is about building constructive habits

Our entire culture and economy Is focused on what we want and not on what we need We get so busy making ourselves look and feel good That we do not pay attention to our health

Jesus came to earth at a certain place and time for a reason Had He come today with our culture and technology We would put Him into an institution He would be though of as unpredictable and impulsive The government would be afraid of Him causing a revolt

Jesus was very comfortable in who He was But He was very uninterested in fame or power His lifestyle might today be described As a kind of homelessness

Christ could have come into any family And yet He chose a very common one He was born into an oppressive empire Where His people were weak and persecuted

He was seen as being totally defeated And publicly shamed and made an example of He remained silent when speaking up mattered most

He was so uninterested in His own welfare That He knowingly triggered the powers that be Not to express Himself or become famous He did it because He was focused on His mission

No religion wants followers that just Go through the motions

God believes in us too much To allow us to continue habits That hurt us and keep us from Him

We often ask what we should do To get into God's Heaven? Maybe we should ask What can we do to please God?

Instead of being saved from hell Maybe we should delight In being reconciled with our Creator

I wonder if we will have chores in Heaven If Christ is the direct living example of God I wonder if we may be asked To do boring things in Heaven

Some of the times I most vividly remember Of encountering very good leaders When I was growing up They were the ones that helped teach me When something needs to get done The leaders and everyone else Just starts doing what is needed

You shouldn't spend the time arguing That you could be better used as a supervisor I saw that once growing up as well

So Christ showed us not the bare minimum He showed us the very most we can give Is what He wants

That is why Christianity can be so difficult God is not content to have you comfortable He wants you to experience Heaven Long before you get there

Faith in America

The problem with the Church today Is not what we believe But how we affect change

The ideas we talk about Are noble indeed But they have unintended consequences

We seem to always be fighting the last battle But at that same time Refuse to learn from history

When we uses money and power Or determines for ourselves objectives Not explicitly mentioned in Scripture We fail to win the hearts and minds Of the people we wish to attract

Considering people in different cultures as the enemy Has not worked and never will

We do not need to compete We need more faith and patience We need people to follow God not us

It is interesting that at the end of Matthew
Jesus answers all the basic questions
Christians always fight over about the end times
Then He spells out exactly what to do to prepare
Jesus tells us to do simple kind things for other people

This implies to me that the Church's biggest problem Would be we are so focused on fighting outward enemies And less on winning over others by our example

Our battle is not with unbelievers Our battle is not primarily with the devil either Our primary battle is between our flesh and spirit

The devil is much more interested in what happens In our minds or Christ's Church Than he cares about unbelievers

As Christians, we, like unbelievers Like to blame others for problems we create This is called projecting in modern psychology

The Church has gone so far fighting
The battle over the existence of God
That they have not emotionally accepted
That God is the Person we are made in the image of

We are so afraid of external threats That we pay too little attention To what happens within us

The few people trying to come to faith today Can't even understand what Bible to use Because this is one of the biggest ideological battles In the Church today

No one needs to oppose us Because we are fighting ourselves

We are basically chasing our own tails

Luckily the survival of Christ's Church Does not depend on us

Most Americans today think of Christians As mentally ill people That enjoy arguing with each over Over things they do not understand

Although this is a vast oversimplification And is not completely accurate This is an unfortunate element of our culture That we have synchronized our faith with

We are told not to start revolutions But there is nothing in the Bible That encourages us to impose our ideas on others

The point is not to control people's opinions about culture But to start thinking more like Christ

We need to accept that the American church Is also a ethnic, linguistic, and socio-economic group

We have to approach evangelism in our own country The same as we prepare To send missionaries to other countries If we want to have any hope Bringing this parallel culture to Christ

We need to empathize with them And not try to changes things

We disagree with If they are not clearly part of Scripture

The real obstacle bringing Christ
To the rest of America
Is to decide amongst ourselves
What is Biblical and what is cultural
About what we believe

If we can find a way to cross subcultures in America We can share the concept worldwide To every culture introduced to Christianity

We are often more concerned with being correct Then following the actions and silence of Christ Maybe we need to change things through prayer and example Rather than power and money

We need to follow our idea of relying Only on scripture to its logical end We need to stop adding traditions, confessions, and interpretations to Scripture

We do not need to clarify what God has said When the focus ends up being a list of things to do We start to be seen as the Pharisees

The focus should be on God Because the point is not for Our ideas and experiences to Be validated But for God to bring people to Himself

We are God's hands and feet We need not do His thinking for Him The Bible does not need to fit into our minds We don't need to civilize God

God needs to be followed in spirit and truth We need to fit into God's creation Not try to make it fit us

Reasons for Faith

When is a Person and an idea One and the same? Is it possible to support a cause But be loyal to a specific Person?

To outsiders religions all look like cults But I can testify about my faith

I have no allegiance to any organization Or any position of leadership I have loyalty to God, family, and believers In that specific order

I feel closer to other believers everywhere Than people living in the same city as me

If I had more than one life to live Maybe I would devote one To helping my fellow Americans Beyond my military service

But both my city and country Are entirely different Than the ones I grew up in I expect greater changes By the time I reach senior citizen age

It seems to be so easy for me to have faith When I have such proof In both my life and our world

I expected the world system To collapse before I turned 30

But the fact that we have not destroyed each other Is enough to convince me of there being A God who is active in His creation

Many Christians feel a need To find intellectual proof for their faith

I have direct experiences in which The only rational explanation Is that God intervened directly

One proof is that I was able to Leave the military early honorably By simply asking for it

Another is that despite having Schizophrenia I can still understand abstract thought My mind seems to be healing over time

I now have a church close to me That is the closest thing I have found To what the people in Heaven would be like

There are more examples
But these are some of the best

When people think of the supernatural They think of real life special effects That they can see, hear, and touch

But anytime God intervenes in our lives Is equally supernatural in nature

God is much more subtle than the devil Likely because the devil lies, kills, and destroys But God is the Creator and is still creating He intervenes constantly in ordinary life

One proof is that His Church is still here The Church is so dysfunctional That the only thing explaining its continued existence Is God's divine intervention

Read the letters of the Apostle Paul If you think the Church succeeded Because of the ability of early church leaders

Christianity is both simple and complex The Bible is easy to understand but hard to follow

God wants to make us think and feel About the decisions we make So we can make better ones

So what is the draw of Christianity? How is Christianity still relevant With everything that has changed in society Especially with all the advances in science and technology?

Global warming is a good example Of our need for God And the devastating effects of sin

Modern technology has a high cost

We have largely solved the problem of hunger In this country at least But we get more cases of heart disease and diabetes Because we eat too many carbs

We have great pain medication
But many people abuse them
So they end up with addictions
And people can't get them when needed

We have extended people's lifespans But now have more cancer

Many people helped build the Internet To empower individuals And share information freely

But it ends up being used for surveillance And angrily debating things We don't even understand nor do we care about

People create works of art more efficiently And more people can express themselves But the value of art drops to nothing And many people try to make money Off another person's work

We have the most powerful military
In the entire world
And we are almost impossible to invade
And yet we are more afraid of other countries

Than ever before in our history

We fight more major wars that any nation ever And win them all quickly and easily But the situation after we leave Is worse for everyone involved

Many people have more access to books than ever before And more people are publishing than ever before But most people have stopped reading

Maybe we are the problem And we need to seek a solution That does not involve us
